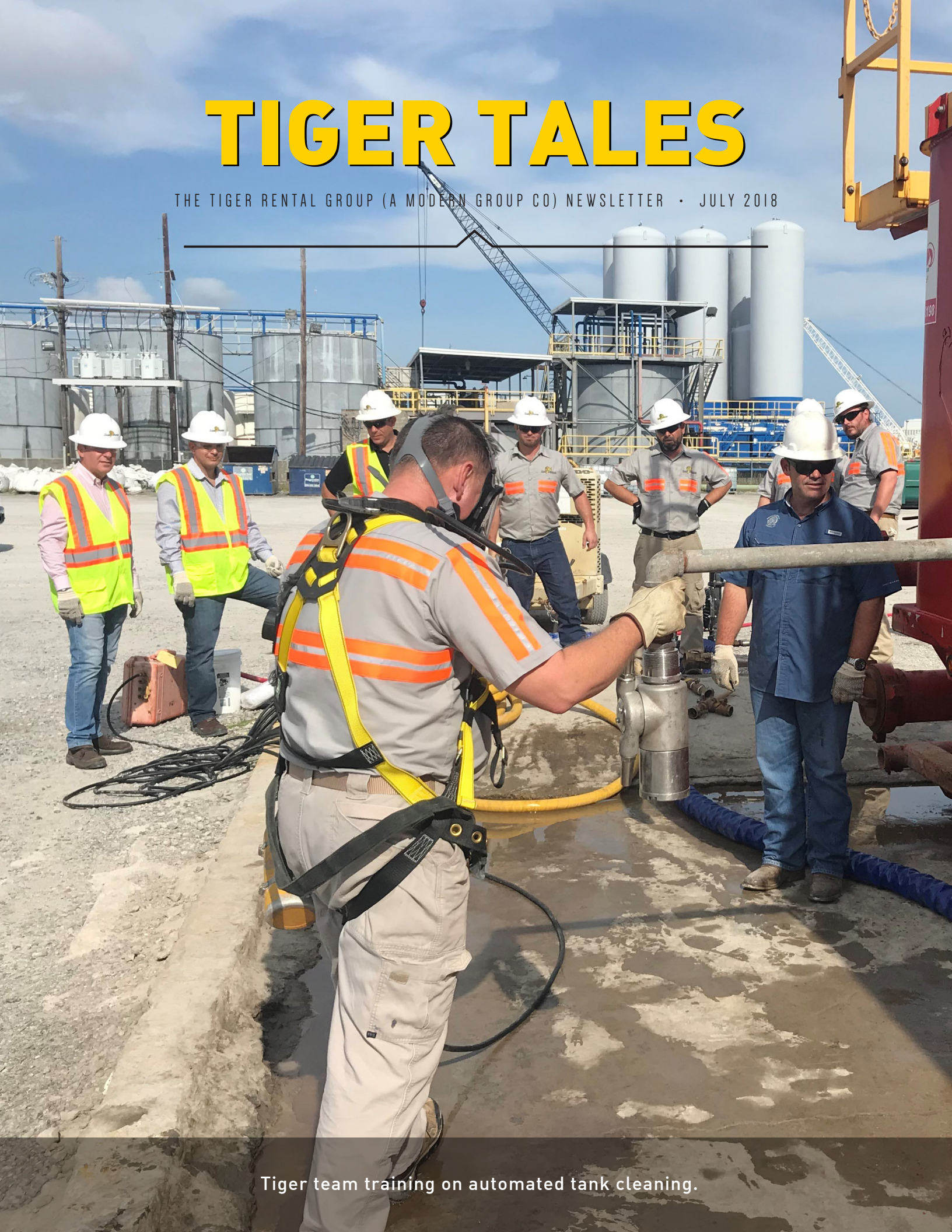

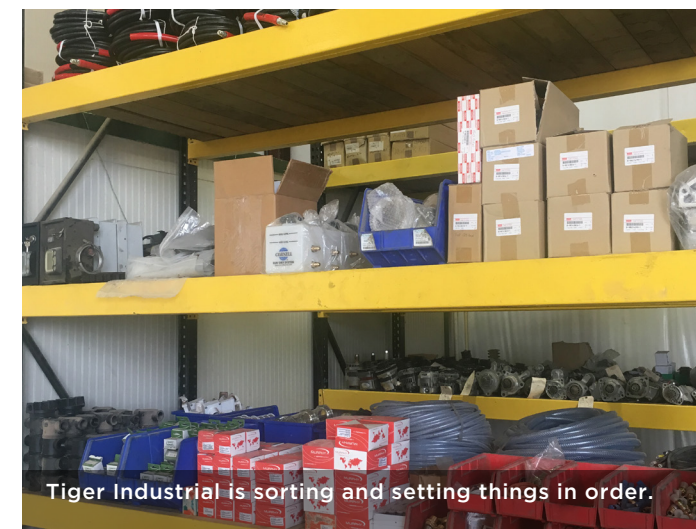
We will continue to improve on all 6 Elements as we grow and move forward in 2018 and beyond!

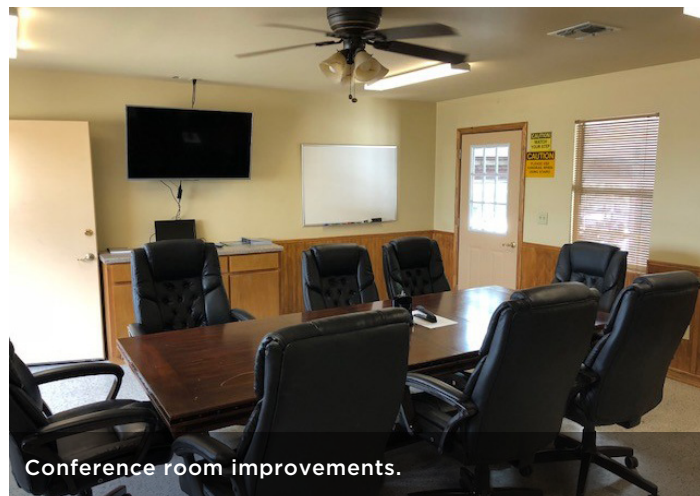

## IN GRUENE, TX

Tiger Industrial Rentals recently held "Senior Level" pump training in New Braunfels, TX. The training was preempted by months of "Freshman and Sophomore" level training, held weekly with the sales and management staff of the Industrial division. With 21 students in attendance, it was a solid two-day event of classroom and hands on training. The event focused on Pump Cavitation, Understanding pH Levels, Root Causes of Premature Pump Failures, Proper Pump & Hose Sizing and applications of same, along with detailed instructions of reading and understanding of Pump Curves and proper pump selection processes. The class was given numerous scenarios to solve during

the two-day event. All hands "tested" at the end of the class with impressive results from all!

A "Hands On" portion of the class was with one of Tiger's newly purchased, Dragon built pumps. The class was taught the proper "Check In" and "Check Out" procedures of our diesel driven, centrifugal pump line. The knowledge obtained at this level of training will give our Tiger sales force and management staff the upper hand against the competition when it comes to pump applications!

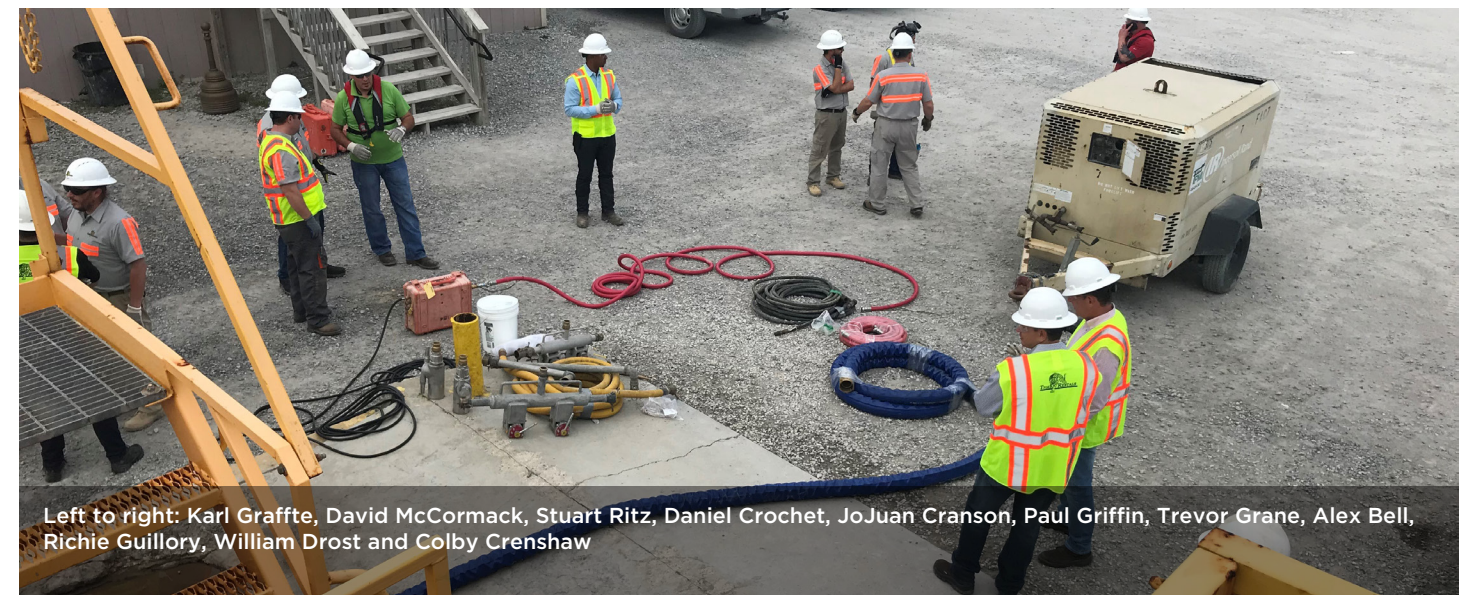

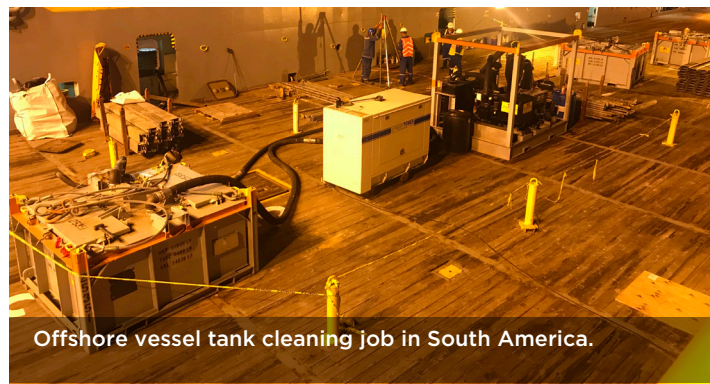

# THINGS ARE HEATING UP

## IN THE MIDDLE EAST

Tiger's Middle East operations are based in the small island country of Bahrain, just off the coast of Saudi Arabia. Saudi Arabia is long known as the most powerful single player in the oil industry. Drilling in the Kingdom has remained the busiest in the world and the rig count has been in excess of 100 for as long as can be remembered and should remain above that number for the foreseeable future.

While Saudi Aramco is the end beneficiary of all oil and gas business in the Kingdom, Tiger has found success by concentrating efforts on the service companies; Weatherford, Halliburton, Baker Hughes and others. We are hearing from our customers that there will be a significant increase in activity in the next two quarters and extending on for the near future. We have seen significant RFQs for our equipment rentals, as well as, purchases.

TOME has seen a steady increase in rentals and revenue in 2017 which has continued into 2018. We have added over 50 of the Dragon used 500bbl Fluid tanks (frac tanks) in 2017 and are adding another 50 in 2018 as well as 6 - 500bbl Coast Guard tanks and 17 mix tanks.

Our success is due to a firm commitment to Tiger fundamentals of service. While the GOM market is accustomed to 24-hour service and the quick response and delivery of equipment when called, it is almost

unheard of in the Kingdom. Our team takes great pride in filling requests made in the middle of the night. Pictures are taken and sent and high-fives all around when the call is answered, and the service provided. We hope to continue and improve on this positive and unique culture.

Opportunities abound with the Bahrain Petroleum Company (Bapco) announcing last year its plan to target unconventional oil offshore. The project includes drilling and fracking - which is uncommon offshore according to Bapco. The state-owned company continues exploration of oil and gas on the edges of the mature Awali (Bahrain) field. In addition to this, Tiger hopes to announce an expansion into another key market in the Middle East.

Tiger Offshore Middle East (TOME) is part of the larger world-wide Tiger team. It is supported by the Tiger family from Texas to Tanzania and from Port Fourchon, Louisiana to Pemba, Mozambique and all areas in between. The International Tiger team is very close in our business efforts and very close personally. We each feel a responsible part of the growth and success of each business unit and for the business as a whole. The talents of the TOME team are freely extended to assist Cyprus, Colombia and Israel, as well as helping other team members to set up operations throughout the Eastern Mediterranean and Africa and even in Canada. A win for one is a win for all, and a challenge for one ignites the efforts of the entire team. We are a proud Tiger team.

# TIGER RENTALS ACQUIRES

## PRODUCTION MANAGEMENT INDUSTRIES, LLC

On December 29, 2017, Tiger Rentals Group and Completions and Production Testing (CPT) Support Services completed an equity acquisition of Production Management Industries, LLC (PMI).

PMI was established in 1971, formed its Environmental Services Group in August 1997, and rebranded in 2013 as PMI Energy Services. This Group has a diverse services package that they deliver from their main headquarters in Morgan City, LA, and facilities in Fourchon, LA, to oil and gas operators on land and offshore in the Gulf of Mexico Region, and the lower Mid-Continent Region from their Midland, TX office.

They provide onshore and offshore production and process equipment cleaning, dockside boat and barge cleaning, site remediation of numerous contaminants from old oil and gas facilities, site restoration to original owner, state, and/or legal specifications, pre-commission and decommissioning services, heat exchanger cleaning, deepwater facility hull column cleaning and inspection, and a shorebase support facility, amongst numerous other service line offerings.

PMI's management staff has a wealth of experience in their niche markets and averages over twenty-two (22) years in the industry – mostly specific to their service offerings.
